We the sisters of St. Mary's Convent, Ramnee, Nainital show great concern for the needy, poor and helpless people finding difficult it to make both ends meet due to COVID-19 Pandemic. Due to lock down we were not allowed to reach out to the needy people in their difficult times. Hence, we approached the authorities placing our project to help out the suffering people. The authorities appointed the police department to help us in this venture. With the help of the Police, we surveyed the needy and suffering people in various villages and in our locality. We prepared the Ration kit consisting of Rice, wheat flower, pulses, oil, sugar, tea leaves, soap and detergent powder which could be used for a month. On a fixed day we called them to a place which is convenient for them. Keeping in mind the Covid -19 Protocols some of us went to distribute the Ration Kits to each family in different groups. We have already distributed to Rag Pickers, Rickshaw pullers, Boat Men (they have no means of living since the tourism was banned due to the pandemic) Catholic families of our parish, Various villages, Leper colony (consisting of 36 Families.) This work of charity will be continued all the more during these difficult times.
